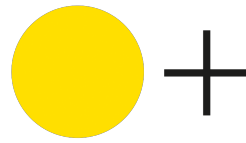



Description:
<p>The first waterproof automatic from Alpina in collaboration with Rolex. The case and movement come from Rolex. The yellow-shaped Oyster case is engraved at the back and front and has a engraved crown. The dial, which is engraved in the center, is enameled, shows Arabic numerals and carries an auxiliary dial for the second.</p> <p>The movement is signed with Rolex and produced in the best quality (Swiss). It is in very good condition. The case was patented by Rolex in 1922, see patent numbers inside the back cover. The screwing the crown no longer works properly, but the crown and the tube are probably original. Overall, everything on the watch seems original and documents a collaboration between Alpina and Rolex from the early days of the watchmaking. Finally.</p> <p>This Rolex model was worn by canal swimmer Gertrud Ederle when a woman first crossed the canal.</p> <p>Please see the macro shots for the details.</p> <p>A milestone in the production of anti-diver watches in an age-appropriate condition in a very rare version.</p>
