Part of the data is collected to ensure a flawless provision of the website. Other data can be used to analyze your user behavior.

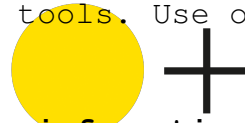
- - What rights do you have regarding your data?

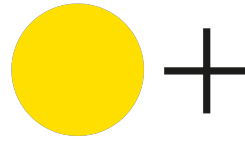

### 3. Data collection on our website

#### Cookies

This website uses a so-called session cookie. This does not harm your computer and contains no viruses. The session cookie is a DSGVO allowed technical cookie and serves to make our offering more user-friendly, effective and secure. Cookies are small text files that are



stored on your computer and stored by your browser.

The session cookie will be automatically deleted as soon as you close your browser. Other cookies are not set by our website (no tracking cookies and no links from our website to other pages.) Other pages are only actively accessible by using links in our offers.

## Server log files

The provider of the pages automatically collects and stores information in so-called server log files, which your browser automatically transmits to us. These are:

- Time of the server request
- IP address

A merge of this data with other data sources will not be done.

The basis for data processing is Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b DSGVO, which allows the processing of data to fulfill a contract or pre-contractual measures.
